National SUZUKI™ Workshop SPAIN 2026

Enjoy a few days of musical learning with your family alongside leading Suzuki Method teachers. The course offers an educational environment inspired by the philosophy of Dr Shinichi Suzuki, combining instrumental training, group practice and cultural activities.

Participants will be able to attend classes and group sessions, as well as enjoy talks and concerts that enrich the learning experience. The course promotes coexistence, exchange between families and learning in a supportive and respectful environment.

It is aimed at both students who are new to the Suzuki Method and advanced students. The course is also open to teachers who wish to consolidate or expand their training, or who want to observe classes taught by internationally renowned Suzuki teachers.

DATES AND LOCATION

22 to 26 July 2026

RIALTA university residence, located in A Zapateira, a short distance from the centre of A Coruña.

The course is RESIDENTIAL

We have reserved 20 places for students without accommodation in the residence, which will be allocated in order of registration, with priority given to residents of A Coruña. They will have to pay a fee per person which includes use of the facilities, 4 meals from 23rd to 26th and the possibility of using the car park.

We are offering 3 days of 'short-term accommodation' for families who live nearby and wish to join the course on the morning of the 23rd. Translated with DeepL.com (free version)

REGISTRATION MODALITIES

SUZUKI BABIES: SECE (Suzuki Early Childhood Education)

- o Aged 0 to 3 years. One class per day (4 sessions).
- o Accompanied by an adult at all times.
- o For children who have not had any previous experience with instruments.
- o Includes course T-shirt.

SUZUKI CHILDREN:

Our goal is to inspire and motivate each child, which is why the schedule is adapted to their age and ability. Includes course T-shirt. All registrations will take place on **each of the four days**:

- **One private lesson and one group class:** duration varies depending on the registration chosen.
- **Complementary activities:** depending on the age, level and type of enrolment of each child, the organisation will assign them to one of the following specialities: jazz, body percussion and rhythms, musicality, choir, etc.

We will send audio recordings and sheet music of the pieces we will be working on in advance.

- o **TWINKLE (Up to the end of book 1)**

20-MINUTE INDIVIDUAL LESSON + GROUP + COMPLEMENTARY

- o **BASIC (Books 2 and 3)**

20-MINUTE INDIVIDUAL LESSON + GROUP + 2 COMPLEMENTARY

- o **INTERMEDIATE (Books 4 y 5)**

30-MINUTE INDIVIDUAL + GRUPAL + ORCHESTRA / ENSEMBLE + 1 COMP.

- o **JUNIOR (Book 6 onwards)**

30-MINUTE INDIVIDUAL + GRUPAL + ORCHESTRA / ENSEMBLE +

CHAMBER or JAZZ (depending on availability) + 1 COMPLEMENTARY.

OBSERVER TEACHERS

Aimed at teachers with Suzuki training and those who want to learn about it.

You will be able to observe any class on the course and also participate in the Jazz and Orchestra groups.

YOUNG STUDENTS WITHOUT AN ACCOMPANIST

All those born in 2014 and earlier may attend the course without an accompanying adult.

The organisation will provide monitors and we will require authorisation from parents or guardians for minors.

SOLO CONCERT

During the course, each young student has the option of playing one of their most polished pieces in one of the concerts held throughout the week.

Participation is voluntary, but it is a wonderful experience to share music with other students, families and teachers.

A few brief recommendations:

- The piece must be "concert-ready". If you are unsure what "concert-ready" means, please consult your teacher.
- If it is not from the Suzuki repertoire and has piano accompaniment, you must send a PDF with the accompaniment score.
- The performance must be done from memory.
- We will ask you to register and provide a recording in order to participate.

PEDAGOGICAL TALKS

Every day, we will be able to attend a Suzuki talk, aimed at parents and teachers. We will organise a childcare service so that you can attend with peace of mind.

JAZZ AND BODY PERCUSSION WORKSHOPS

For participants who do not have these activities in their schedule, you can try them out and participate in one of the workshops on a voluntary basis. Subject to availability.

PARENTS' ORCHESTRA

We will form an orchestra for parents who wish to participate.

LEISURE AND GAMES WORKSHOP

Various activities in which you can participate voluntarily, for your free time, designed for fun and to facilitate family harmony. In the afternoons, we will do outdoor activities.

REGISTRATION

All attendees must complete the registration form on the Federation's website: www.federacionmetodosuzuki.es

- The registration period begins on 2 February at 12:00 noon.
- Last day for registration: 30 April.
- Places are limited. Once they are filled, we will open a waiting list..

ONCE YOU HAVE REGISTERED:

Once you have completed and submitted your registration form, you will need to pay a €50 deposit to secure your place, which will be deducted from the total amount payable.

After a few days, you will receive an email with your place allocation and the total amount to be paid for the course. Please check your spam folder if you do not receive this email, or contact us..

PAYMENT IN TWO INSTALMENTS:

When the total cost exceeds €600, payment can be made in two instalments.

The first payment must be made before 1 May and the second before 7 June.

REFUNDS

If for any reason you wish to cancel your registration or are unable to attend the course, you must send a written request to the Federation's email address.

For refund requests made before 15 May 2026, 75% of the amount paid will be refunded. No refunds will be made for cancellations after 16 May. We will always respond to your requests to find the best solution.

In any case of cancellation for reasons beyond the control of the organisation, the €50 charged for activating the place reservation will not be refunded as it covers administrative and management costs.

ACCOMODATION

Accommodation and activities will take place at the **RIALTA university residence**, located in **A Zapateira**, a short distance from the city of **A Coruña**.

It has a **self-service dining room**, a menu with 3 options for the first course, 3 for the second course and 3 for dessert, vegetarian menus and menus adapted to food intolerances (on request), a **bar-cafeteria**, a **gym**, an **indoor swimming pool**, a **fenced-in sports area**, **spacious common areas**, a **laundry room**, **Wi-Fi connection** and **parking**.

Free bus service that connects you to the centre of A Coruña in 10 minutes (frequencies set by Rialta).

The accommodation consists of **single, double and triple rooms**, all with **private bathrooms**, equipped with a **sink, fridge, microwave** and **bed linen**. Rooms are cleaned daily.

ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

- o Accommodation for children up to 3 years of age is free of charge without occupying a bed.
- o Accommodation covers dinner on the 22nd to lunch on the 26th. (4 nights' accommodation).
- o We offer "short stay" accommodation for families living nearby.
- o Check-in on the 23rd at 8:30 a.m.; covers from lunch on the 23rd to lunch on the 26th (3 nights' accommodation).
- o Unless expressly requested, we will not mix families in rooms, which will be assigned by the organisation.
- o For single registrations who wish to share a room, you can indicate the name of the person you wish to share with on the registration form. If this is not indicated, the organisation will propose a roommate based on compatibility criteria.
- o One of the guests in a triple room must be under 12 years of age.
- o Young students who are coming unaccompanied will preferably be accommodated in double rooms.
- o The use of the facilities, except for the classrooms and dining room, is reserved for those who have accommodation.

ATTENDEES WITHOUT CONTRACTED ACCOMMODATION

Attendees without accommodation will have to pay a fee of €60 per person, which includes four meals from the 23rd to the 26th, plus the fee for access to the centre and use of the car park, subject to availability.
