Welcome to the Spanish Suzuki Workshop!

Everything you need to know to make the absolute most of it

To make sure everything runs like clockwork and we all enjoy an unforgettable few days filled with music, we've put together a few really important reminders for both the little ones and the grown-ups. Please have a proper read through!

FOR OUR STUDENTS

- **Your instrument, always ready to go:** Before you head over, give it a bit of love! Make sure it's clean and in tip-top condition so you don't run into any hiccups during classes.
- **Don't leave anything behind!** Remember to pack all your accessories in your suitcase: spare strings, bow, shoulder rest, rosin... everything you use day in, day out. If you play the cello or guitar and use a special stool, bring it along! And for the littlest ones, don't forget your mat or footrest, as we won't have any spares available there.
- **See you in the ORCHESTRA!** If you're playing in one, please bring your music stand from home, clearly marked with your name. If you don't have one or happen to forget it, don't worry: we'll have a few folding music stands for sale at the office for €20 (cash only).
- **Punctuality is key:** Try to get to class a few minutes early. That way, you'll have plenty of time to unpack your instrument, settle any nerves, and start the session full of energy. This is super important so we can keep things running on time for everyone!
- **Looking sharp for the big day:** For **the final concert**, we'll all be dressing the same in **the official Course T-shirt**. It's going to look amazing!

FOR MUMS, DADS, AND GUARDIANS

- **The classroom atmosphere:** The little ones need a lot of concentration. We are incredibly grateful for your help in keeping an atmosphere of respect, and please remember to pop your phone on silent before coming in.
- **All sorted before we start:** To avoid any interruptions and make sure they get 100% out of the class, please ensure they've had a bite to eat, a drink, and a trip to the loo before the session begins.

- **Photos and videos:** We know you'll want to capture these lovely moments, but please remember to always ask the teachers for permission before recording. Also, for privacy reasons, you are only allowed to film your own children.
- **ID on at all times!** At reception, we'll hand out name badges so we all know who's who (teachers, families, organisers...). Both adults and students must wear them visibly to enter classes and activities. We've also provided stickers with the names of the littlest ones, just in case the badges get in the way while they play.
- **Time for everyone:** While you enjoy the talks in peace, the children will have a fun activity planned just for them. Oh, and please feel completely free to join in and have a brilliant time with your kids in the Percussion and Rhythm classes!
- **Logistics at Rialta:** If you're driving and have booked accommodation, you can use the on-site car park. To keep energy levels up, students will have a designated snack time, and for the adults, the residence has a café with very long opening hours for a proper cup of coffee.
- **Care and consideration:** Please remember that minors are under the responsibility of their parents or guardians at all times. At Rialta, we'll be sharing the space with others, so we kindly ask you to avoid shouting, running down the corridors, or loud music.
- **A good night's sleep for all:** To guarantee everyone gets a proper rest, we will observe absolute silence and will not practice instruments from 10:00 pm to 8:00 am, and from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm. If you get back to your room late, please tiptoe in—everyone else will thank you for it!
- **Responsibility and tidiness:** Please look after the facilities as if they were your own home. Any damage caused by misuse will be the responsibility of those involved. Furthermore, neither Rialta nor the organisers can accept responsibility for loss or theft, so do keep a close eye on your belongings! When you leave, please make sure your room is tidy and let reception know if anything isn't working quite right.
